STANDARDISED PRICE LIST

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director's charges only)£2770 This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.	
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements£1300Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care£250Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceasedperson will be kept at the funeral director's branch premises.£350Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from Oak veneer – starting from£470Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral£50(viewing outside of these hours will incur additional charges)£4 a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct tothe agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle£350	
UNATTENDED FUNERAL This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

DDITIONAL FUNERAL DIRECTOR PRODUCTS AND SERVICES his funeral director may be able to supply a range of optional, additional products and services, or to rrange (on your behalf) for a third party to supply them. Examples include:	
Additional mileage (price per mile) Additional transfers of the deceased person's body (e.g. to their home,	£2.80
to a place of worship etc during working hours.) (price per transfer)	£300
Collection and delivery of ashes	£10
Embalming	
Funeral officiant (e.g. celebrant, minister of religion etc.) Services supplied outside of normal office hours	£220 – £260

The funeral director can give you a full list of what they can supply. They are likely to charge for these additional products and services, so you may choose to take care of some arrangements without their involvement, or you can use a different supplier.

This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening 1 and closing an existing grave. In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to
